

CITY OF LANCASTER RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

- Place recyclables at curbside in the green bin after 6 p.m. the night before your collection day.
- Please rinse items and remove caps.
- DO NOT place items in plastic bags for collection.
- DO NOT place items in cardboard boxes.
- Recycle bins are free and are available by calling the Solid Waste Hotline at 717-291-4744.

YES – Aluminum cans, steel cans, glass bottles and jars, plastic bottles: soda, water milk jugs, iced-tea jugs, laundry detergent bottles and newsprint.



NO – Please no plastic cups, styrofoam plates, no plastic food tubs, aluminum foil, pie plates, cookware, tissues, napkins or plastic bags.



IT IS ILLEGAL TO REMOVE ANY MATERIALS FROM THE GREEN BINS ONCE THEY ARE PLACED AT CURBSIDE FOR COLLECTION.

COLLECTION BASICS FOR CITY CUSTOMERS

- Residents may place up to (6) - 32 gallon bags or cans each week or:
- A large refuse item may be placed at the curbside in lieu of two bags.
- If bags exceed the limit, extra refuse bag tags may be purchased at 39 W. Chestnut St, the Bureau of Treasury
- Refuse bags/cans may not exceed 30 lbs. in weight, if they exceed the weight limit they will not be collected.
- Refuse/recycling must be placed at curbside after 6 p.m. the night before collection.
- Refuse/recycling containers must be removed from curbside by 8 p.m. the day of collection.
- Refuse/recycling containers may not be stored in front of property or on the front porch in view by the public.
- No construction or demolition debris will be collected.
- No appliances will be collected.
- No "clean out" piles or "move out" piles will be collected – Please make arrangements with a permitted collector for clean outs.
- Recycling is the law. All residents are required to recycle plastic bottles (soda bottles, milk or iced tea jugs, laundry detergent bottles, #1 & #2, glass bottles and jars, aluminum cans, steel or bimetallic cans, and newsprint.

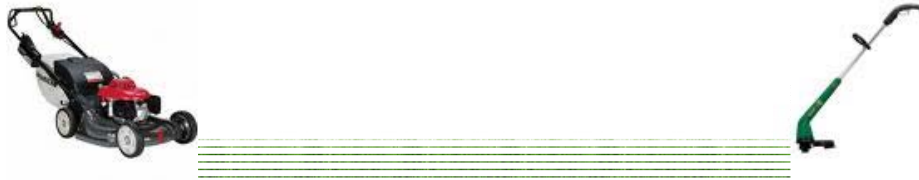


Prevent litter:

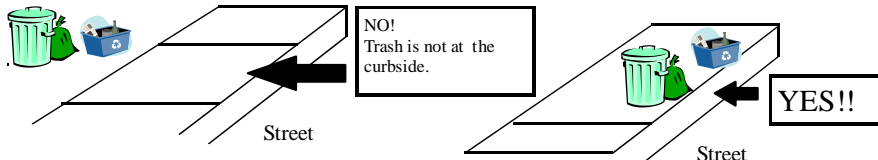
Only place your refuse out in tied bags. Loose trash, even in containers leads to litter and to the attraction of animals. Bag it up, tie it up and get it picked up!

Please remember to trim all weeds and cut the grass routinely. Weeds, grass or other vegetation may not exceed six inches in height.
