

**Minutes
Lancaster City Noise Control Hearing Board
May 10, 2016**

The meeting of the Lancaster City Noise Control Hearing Board was called to order at 4:04 PM in the Mayor's Conference Room at City Hall, May 10, 2016.

Board members present: Clair McCormick, Kenneth Hammel, Marshall Snively, Sam Wilsker, Gary Hufford and City Zoning Officer Walter Siderio. Representing the petitioning *Iglesia de Cristo Misionera, M.I., Inc.* was Jose Carlos Parrilla and William Torres.

McCormick asked if there were any corrections or additions to the April 12, 2016 meeting minutes, previously distributed. Hearing none, they were approved as written.

NEW BUSINESS

There was one appeal submitted to the Board for their action:

Jose Carlos Parrilla, representing *Iglesia de Cristo Misionera, M.I., Inc.*, of 47 W. Farnum Street, appealed for variance to Section 198-4-B of the Noise Ordinance for live, amplified music/speaker at his facility every other Friday evening from April until the end of August, from the hours of 7 PM to 8PM. Due to the meeting schedule, Mr. Parrilla's request was modified from an "April", to May 13th commencement date.

No one from the public was in attendance to offer supporting or refuting testimony. It was noted that the property is a rental property with Mr. Parrilla being the tenant; the landlord was not in attendance to support the request.

The Board expressed its hesitation to approve due to the residential nature of the neighborhood. Mr. Parrilla assured the Board that he had the support of the neighbors and that he would not create a disruption to the neighborhood.

With this assurance and the warning that any disruption and complaint would result in the non-approval of any further action, the Board agreed to allow Mr. Parrilla a 30 day variance, allowing for two Friday night services in May. Mr. Parrilla was invited to return to the Board in June to revisit the results of the temporary variance and appeal for a variance for the period June through August 2016. Mr. Parrilla was agreeable to the 30 day variance and would be appearing again at the June 14th meeting.
