Quorum was not met at this meeting. The following notes are from the public art manager (HL).

PUBLIC ART MANAGER'S UPDATE

1. **Central Market Visibility** – All sign poles have been installed. HL and Matt Metzler will meet Marketechs shop manager on 8/11 at 9 am to field measure all sign locations. Goal is to have signs installed, to coincide with conclusion of streetscape renovations, by Harvest Breakfast.
2. **Our Identities Unedited** - The Lancaster Sound Map Exhibition at LOOP de-install on 8/22, at that time the exhibition will move to Millersville Univ, Winter Center Art Gallery. Related events TDB.
3. **City Hall Gallery** – Alysha Plaza “The World Around Me” July and August. Alysha Plaza will be at Gallery 8/5, 5 - 8 p.m. Emily Adleblute, Lancaster City Landscape paintings will run Sept/Oct.
4. **Litter Letter Project** - Litter Letters have been returned to the New Holland Pike Recycling Center for display, until we receive a new project proposal. Approx.\$900 remains from original LCSWMA grant for an additional project. Please feel free to share RFP.
5. **Art Display Cases at Train Station** – Second exhibition installed on 7/12, 9-11 am. Thanks to AR for helping manage install. Renee Piechocki and Jennifer McGregor recommend these cases as a possible “Platform” perhaps for NW? Very visible location. Very public platform for local, regional, artists to showcase. Good first entry into the realm of public art. We may need to regroup a small committee.
6. **MLK Elementary Pool** - Draft sign content created. Libby Modern will help with design later in Aug. NL and HL discussed possible template or guideline for public art signs for consistency.
7. **Public Art Master Plan** – July 19/20 visit with RP and JMc, presented Draft Framework. Received feedback and are now working to buildout plan. Additional comments or feedback from PAAB? Priorities? We will discuss further at next board meeting.

8. **Gateway Banners** – WT and HL will meet on 8/3 to discuss project next steps and committee goals.
9. **PAAB Onboarding Communications** – HL prepared draft of content and timeline, for review by NL and MN. Will gather feedback, make final edits and then share with PAAB for review/approval - possibly by September board meeting
10. **Fundraising** – ExtraGive is 11/18/16 Registration is due 9/5 for early registration, 10/3 final. Consider strategic content for info supplied on application.
