**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANCASTER  
ACCEPTING THE GREEN LIGHT-GO GRANT.**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Lancaster was awarded a Green Light-Go Grant in the amount of \$387,825 from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation for the installation of Accessible Pedestrian Signals at twenty intersections throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the pedestrian signals will greatly improve pedestrian safety in Lancaster.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Council of the City of Lancaster of the County of Lancaster hereby accepts the grant in the amount of \$387,825 from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to be used for the installation of twenty pedestrian signals.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that J. Richard Gray, Mayor, hereby has the authority to sign all documents and agreements between the City of Lancaster and the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
