Primary Function

This is routine, semi-skilled and clerical work in reading and servicing water meters.

Principle Duties & Responsibilities

Follows safe practices in the performance of duties.

- Read meters, makes special checks for accuracy and records findings by using paper or computerized equipment.
- Performs intricate wiring of water meters and other devices.
- Turns water service on and off; delivers delinquent notices.
- Maintains records according to established procedures.
- Inspects various equipment and services, including: water pipes for leaks; frozen lines; underground pipe installation for new service; backflow preventers; pressure reducers; high/low pressure problems in the meter pit, customer's home or place of business.
- Provides temporary water to customers who are without water due to water line repair or replacement.
- Installs and removes water meters.
- Requires answering incoming calls and dispatching service trucks to answer emergencies; sets up appointments and gets readings.
- Tests and rebuilds water meters on the meter test bench.
- Keeps supplies stocked, organized and replenished in the service vehicle and the meter shop.

Position Qualifications

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of safe practices related to water meter servicing.
- Proven ability to write legibly and to do simple math calculations of addition and subtraction is required.
- Proven ability to read City and county maps and to navigate by foot and automobile within a territory is required.
- Proven ability to maintain simple and accurate records is required.
- Proven proficiency in knowledge, understanding and use of the Microsoft (or similar) suite of tools (Word, and Excel, Outlook or Lotus Notes) is required.
- Proven ability to perform computer data entry and retrieval is required.
