The City of Lancaster, PA will receive proposals online for City of Lancaster City Hall Entrance until August 11th, 2021, at 11:00AM at which time they shall be opened electronically and publicly posted on PennBid's website. The City of Lancaster is seeking bids for the construction of Lancaster City Hall Entrance. The work includes the selective demolition of the existing entrance landing, steps and adjacent section of sidewalk and curb, the construction of a new sidewalk, and curb, steps, ramp and landing including welded metal handrail.
